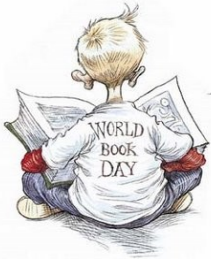

Cygnets Programme...

Cygnets is a parenting support programme for parents & carers, including grandparents, uncles, aunts, shared carers of children and young people with an autistic spectrum condition. The programme is delivered over 7 x 3 hour sessions. The programme is designed to increase the understanding of autistic spectrum conditions, help parents develop their knowledge on how a child on the autistic spectrum experiences the world and what drives their behaviour, Guide parents through practical strategies they can use with the children, direct parents to relevant (local and national) ASC resources, give parents the opportunity to meet with other parents who have had similar experiences and to gain support and learn from each other.
