

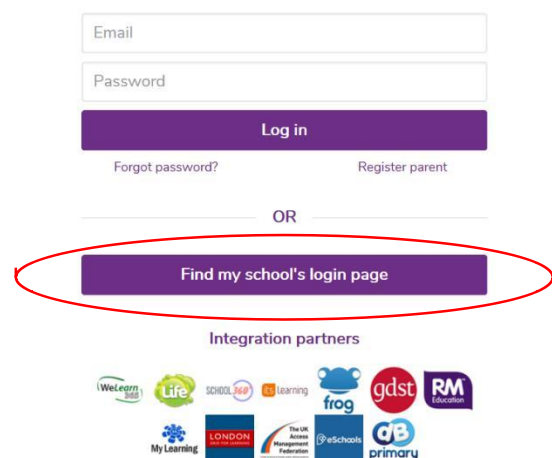
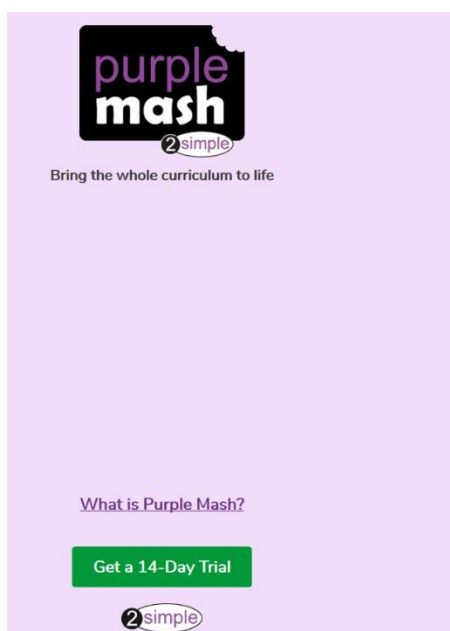
Purple Mash

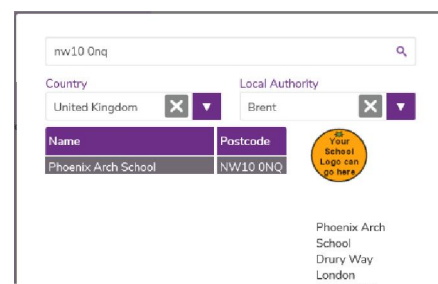
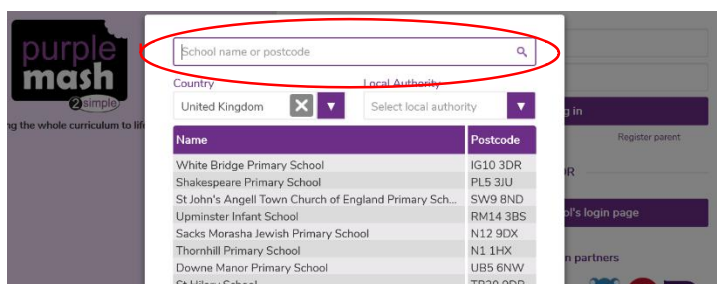
Every child in school will have their own unique login to be able to access the website through our own school portal. This portal can be accessed at home, with your password and login information and by using the following steps.

1. Visit www.purplemash.com on your computer/tablet to get to the login page. Click on the **Find my school's login page** link to get to our unique school portal.

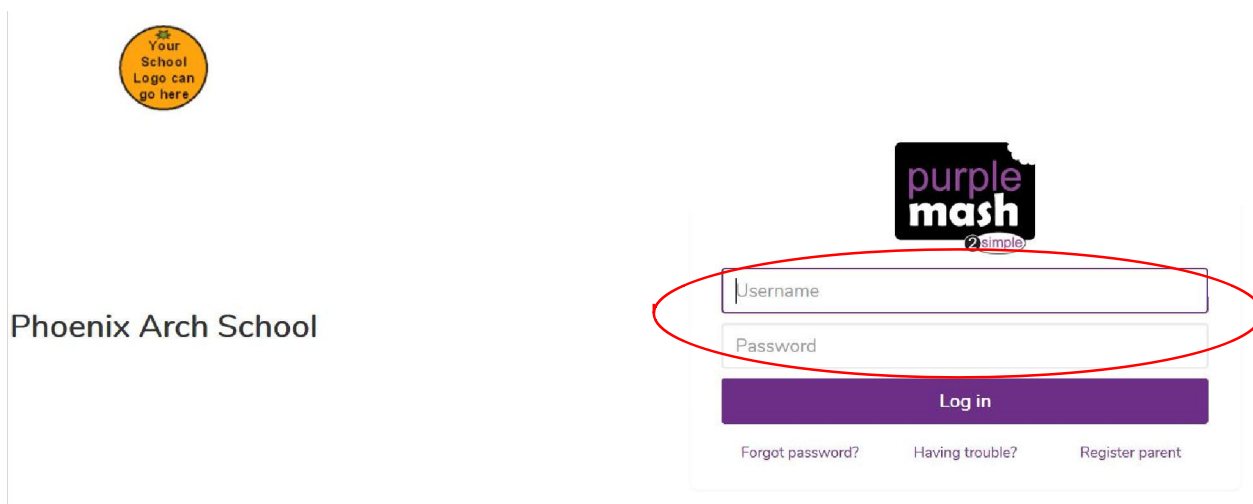

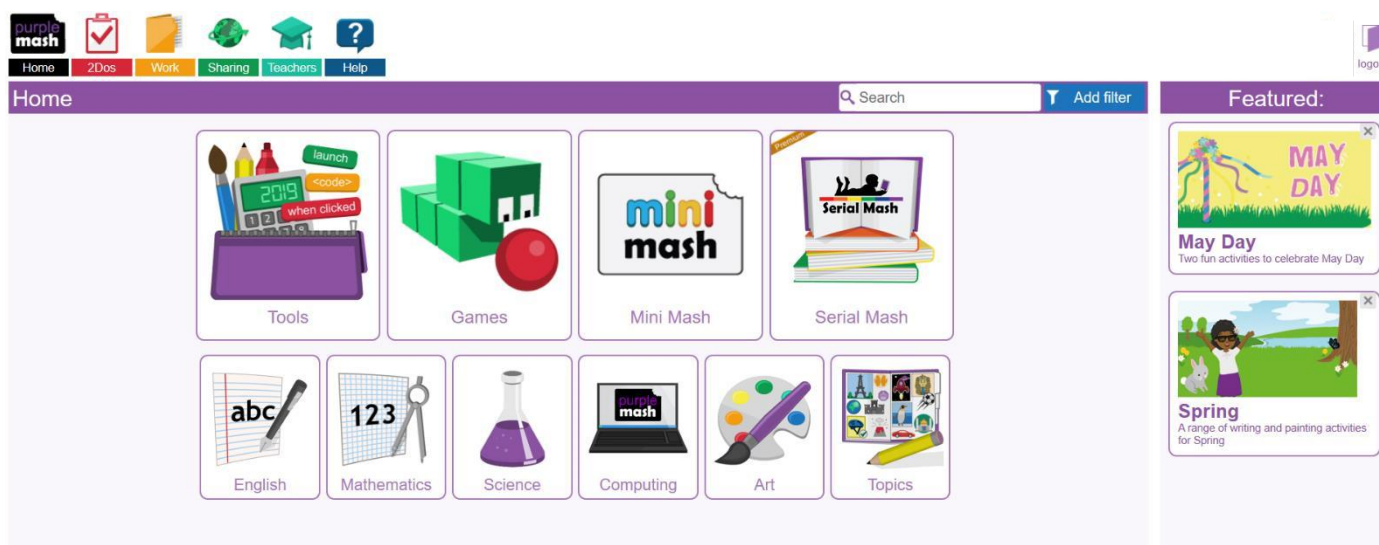




3. From here, the children will be able to type in their own username and password, which you will find on their unique card, and **Log in**.
