

## School Uniform

Our school has a uniform/ dress code that can be purchased from our office. We have taken into consideration pupil's needs and costs in developing our approach to uniform.

We expect all pupils to have at least one school jumper with our logo on and at least one gold coloured polo shirt both purchased from the school.

These are sold to parents at cost to the school and the school does not benefit financially from the purchase.

Additional polo shirts can be purchased from many supermarkets or on line, although these are yellow. You can also purchase dark grey or black trousers, joggers or skirts/pinafores, which completes the school uniform. These should not have any logos on or be fashion items. In the summer pupils can also choose to wear purple check dresses, also reasonably priced from stores.

Pupils should wear their own black shoes or trainers and again these should not be fashion items with logos. Your child should be able to tie any laces or fastenings independently and so please ensure you purchase shoes that supports independence. Pupils should not wear wellingtons throughout the day as this poses safety issues on the playground.

Our aim is that pupils feel comfortable and develop a sense of belonging by wearing our uniform, but we do recognise that many pupils may need time to adjust to this. We also want to discourage competitiveness with older pupils who want designer / branded trainers; we therefore ask that you support the schools decision not to allow these.

Our PE kit is a plain shirt of any colour with shorts / joggers. All pupils must have trainers or plimsolls to engage in PE or sports.

Many of our parents hand in uniform to school that their child has outgrown and we are able to give this to families if requested.
